

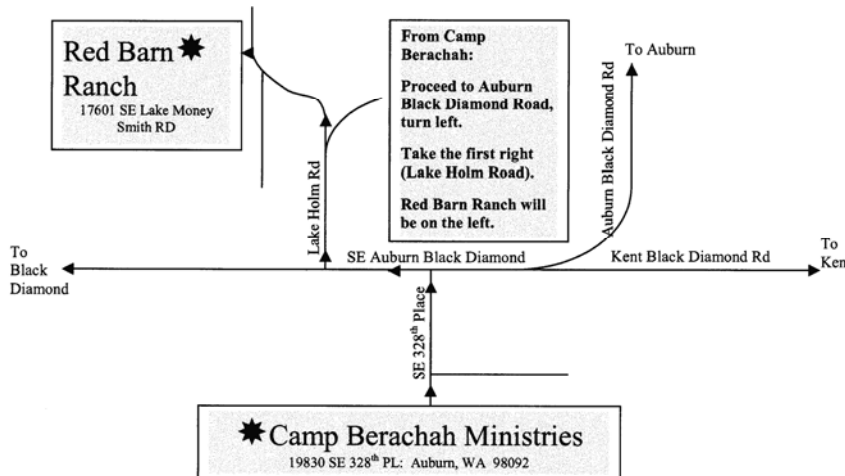
**DIRECTIONS TO CAMP:** From I-5, get on Highway 18 East heading to Auburn (exit #142A). Drive approximately 6 miles; take the Auburn-Black Diamond Road exit. Turn right at end of exit. Drive approximately 5 miles; turn right at stop merging onto SE Auburn-Black Diamond Road. Go .5 mile, turn left onto SE 328<sup>th</sup> Place and follow to the end into Camp.

**DIRECTIONS TO RED BARN:** Come just like you would to Camp on SE Auburn-Black Diamond Road, but go past 328th Place (road to main Camp) and take the next right, Lake Holm Road. Veer left at the "Y" onto SE Lake Moneysmith Rd. Red Barn Ranch is on the left, through an open gate entrance-17601 SE Lake Moneysmith Rd.

## Camper General Packing List (overnight/horse camps-see below for additional items)

- Bag/backpack
- water bottle
- sunscreen, bug spray
- weather appropriate clothes
- modest one-piece swimsuit
- pool towel, extra clothes
- sack lunch w/drink for Day Camps
- closed-toe shoes (climbing wall, bikes, go karts)
- spending money (approximately \$2 per day)
- Bible and notebook
- plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes
- long pants (if horse riding)

### CLASSIC AND RED BARN DAY CAMPS BRING: Sack lunch and drink

Optional hot lunch available for Classic Day Camp - \$29 (must pre-register)

### OVERNIGHT CAMPS ADD:

Sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight, sweatshirt and jacket, extra shoes, hygiene items (meals provided)

### HORSE CAMPS ADD:

Boots and a pair of shoes. Riding helmets and boots are provided (limited quantity) or bring your own.

#### ✓ Things not to bring:

CD players, Ipods, MP3's, stereos or personal listening devices, cell phones, fireworks or other noise-making devices, high value items (cost or sentiment), video games, Weapons i.e. guns (real or toy), knives, pepper spray, laser pointers, explosive devices or any item that could be considered threatening. Any questionable items will be confiscated.

## Camper Arrival and Check In

### Check in locations:

All Extended care is located at Camp Berachah-campers check in & out at parking lot in front of gymnasium. Red Barn Extended Care campers will be transported to Camp Berachah's pm extended care. Classic Day Camp, Overnight Horse, Primary, Teen, Junior, Soccer, CIT, WIT check in/out first parking lot Red Barn Day Camp-check in at Red Barn Ranch (see map on first page)

- ✓ **Classic Day Camp/Overnight Horse/Red Barn Day Camp check-in at 9am**
- ✓ **Preschool Morning check-in 10am**
- ✓ **Primary/Junior/Teen check-in 10am**
- ✓ **WIT check-in at 9am; CIT check-in at 8:30am; Soccer check-in at 8:30am-bus to Buck Creek (parents will pick up their campers at Buck Creek on Saturday)**

Check in process: Camper check-in will not begin prior to above times. Registration can take up to an hour.

1. Day Campers **see hanging rosters on reader board** for group assignment and go to group number. Overnight campers check in at registration tent for cabin assignment then report to group number.
2. Please update us with any changes in your camper's registration.
3. Check in all medication with camp nurse (at registration tent).
  - **Medication:**
    - Everything must be in the original containers, labeled with the patient's name and the physician's ordered dose on the bottle
    - (e.g., pills in Ziploc baggies are not okay)
    - Campers are allowed to carry one inhaler with them at camp, if medically necessary
4. Sign in with your camper's counselor under child's Group Number
  - **Be sure to notify counselor if someone else will be picking up your camper**
  - **If you have pre-registered for a horse ride the counselor will have your campers bracelet with their assigned time-no need to stand in horse line**

## Camp Expectations:

- ✓ Campers are expected to follow camp rules and accept the authority of counselors and camp leadership. CB Staff may elect to send home any campers who refuse to comply with rules. (i.e. Harassment/bullying of other campers or inappropriate language)
- ✓ **Camper Visitors:** All visitors (family, friends) are discouraged from visiting campers while camp is in session, except for designated events (parent programs listed below).
- ✓ **Camper-Parent phone calls** are discouraged, as they encourage homesickness. If there is an emergency, please contact the camp office.
- ✓ **Camper Mail/Email:** To send your camper a letter, postcard or package, please drop it off at the camp office or mail to the camp with Camper's Name and Session Code clearly marked on the package. *Please send at least 3 days prior to your camper's session.* See our web site for camper email option available through Bunk 1 (**Registration Code 119028B**). **Mail delivery and Camper Email-not available for camps at Buck Creek, Day or Primary Camps.**
- ✓ **Lost & Found:** We are not responsible for items lost or left at camp. Please take time to check for any lost items at our lost and found area before leaving camp. After 2 weeks all items are donated to a local charity.
