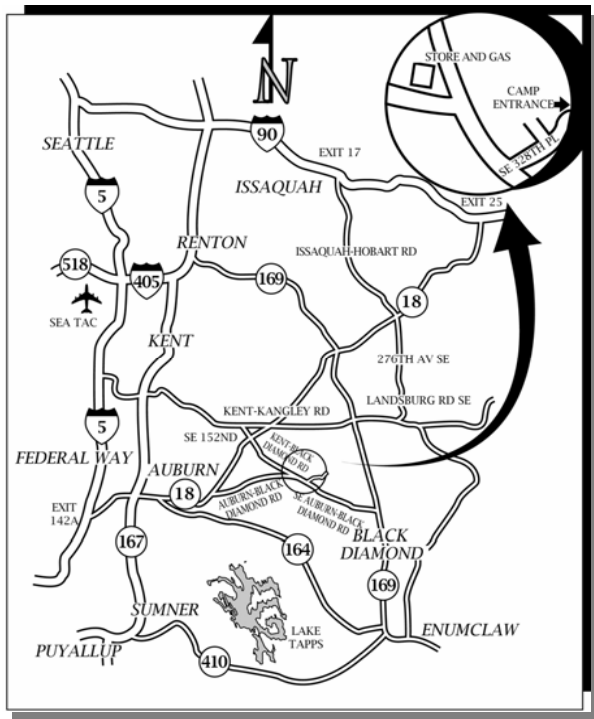


ABOUT CHA

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From your location, get onto Highway 18 towards Auburn (from I-5 or I-90). From Highway 18, take the Auburn-Black Diamond Road exit and turn right at the end. Go 6 miles and turn right onto SE Auburn-Black Diamond Road. Go .5 mile and turn left onto SE 328th Place. Follow road into camp.

CLINIC REQUIREMENTS

Participants **MUST** meet the following requirements to participate in the CHA Standard Instructor Certification Clinic.

- ✓ Be 16 years or older to receive Assistant Instructor certification.
- ✓ Be 18 years or older to receive the Instructor certification at any level.
- ✓ Experience in horsemanship with good control at the walk, trot and lope or canter.
- ✓ Can catch, lead, saddle and handle horses without assistance.
- ✓ Prior teaching experience is helpful.
- ✓ There is a 210 lbs weight limit for clinics.

Certification will depend on meeting CHA standards, especially in safety and ability to work effectively with people and horses at the level desired. Both English and Western will be offered for certification.

Starts: Monday, June 6th @ 8:30am

Ends: Friday, June 10th @ 5:00pm



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Clinic cost \$675 per person. Includes meals, housing, materials & clinic costs

- You **MUST BE** present for all of the clinic to receive certification
- Minimum non-refundable deposit of \$100 due with registration. ***Materials & Manuals will be sent after deposit is received.***
