INSTRUCTORS OF RIDERS WITH DISABILITIES CERTIFICATION CLINIC (WITH SETO) STANDARD EQUIVALENCY TEST-OUT

PURPOSE

This clinic is specifically for instructors working in programs that provide therapeutic, recreational, or mainstream riding for people with disabilities. The materials and curriculum of this certification clinic are specific to the various considerations, adaptations, applications, contraindications, adaptive equipment and horses used in riding programs that serve people with physical and/or cognitive disabilities.

SETO: STANDARD EQUIVALENCY TEST OUT

A two day evaluation precedes the CHA-IRD clinic for candidates who wish to waive the CHA standard level two instructor certification. Upon successful completion of the 2 day evaluation, the IRD candidate is eligible for Level 1 CHA-IRD certification in the clinic to follow.

Certification

Level of certification earned is based on the candidate's CHA standard certification, their individual performance in IRD clinic, scores on written examination, and documentation of experience and other prerequisites.

Certification is awarded at the end of the clinic, and the level of certification awarded (if any) is the sole discretion of the two CHA Clinicians conducting the clinic. Certification is valid for three years from the certification date. The instructor must maintain annual individual membership in CHA.
